2009-2010 SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

Purpose:

To provide financial assistance to offset college expenses. Funds awarded may be used to defray the expense of college tuition and fees.

Goal:

To award two(2) \$1,000 college scholarships to two(2) students graduating in the 2009-10 school year from a Public, Private or Home School in the Arlington, Mansfield and/or Kennedale, Texas service area.

Selection Process:

Open to high school seniors graduating in 2010 that are interested in any discipline. Selection for the Arlington Board of REALTORS® Scholarship will be based on the following criteria:

1. Student essay, maximum 500 words, entitled "How the Arlington Board of REALTORS® Scholarship will help me in preparing for my future." Scoring will be based on content, originality and overall impression.
2. Two Letters of Recommendation, from a teacher, counselor, school administrator, minister or any other person over 21 years of age, who is not related to the applicant. **Please DO NOT mention the student's name in these letters.**
3. Academic Record- School Transcript(s)
4. School and Community Involvement
5. Financial Need

The Arlington Board of REALTORS® may require a personal interview with a finalist. If an interview is necessary, it will be conducted at the student's high school with either a parent/guardian or counselor present.

Submission Process: Packet MUST include all of the following to be considered.

1. Application must be completely filled out, including all signatures. (First)
2. Completed Essay (Second)
3. Official High School Transcript (Third)
4. Letters of Recommendation (Fourth)

Please do not send any photos with your submission or staple any pages together.

Incomplete packets will not be considered.

COMPLETED APPLICATION MUST BE POSTMARKED NO LATER THAN MARCH 31 and HAND DELIVERIES MUST BE RECEIVED by APRIL 5, 2010, before 5:00 p.m.
